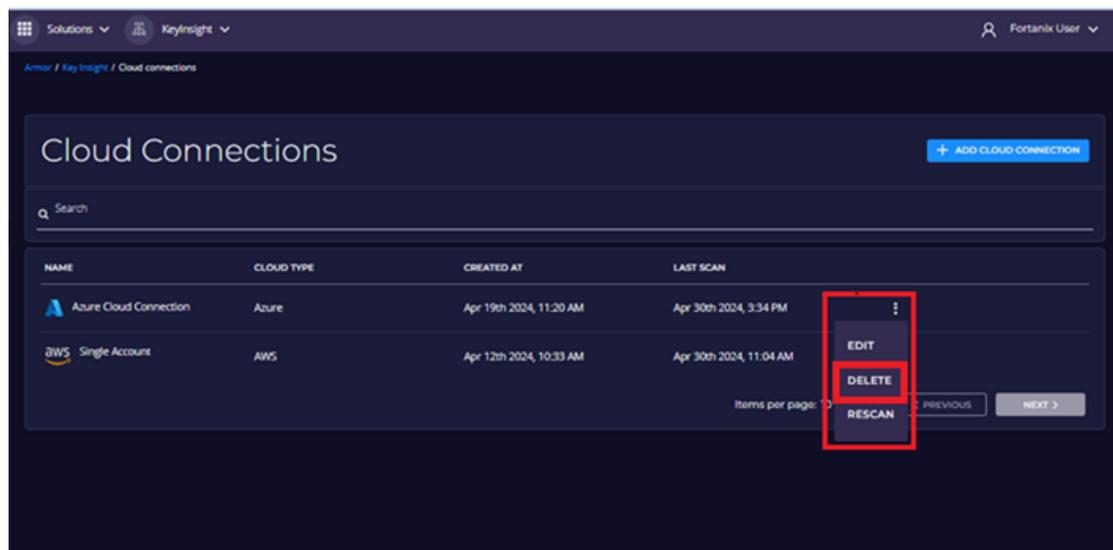
## OVERVIEW

When you delete a cloud connection, any related scanned data and assessment data will also be deleted.



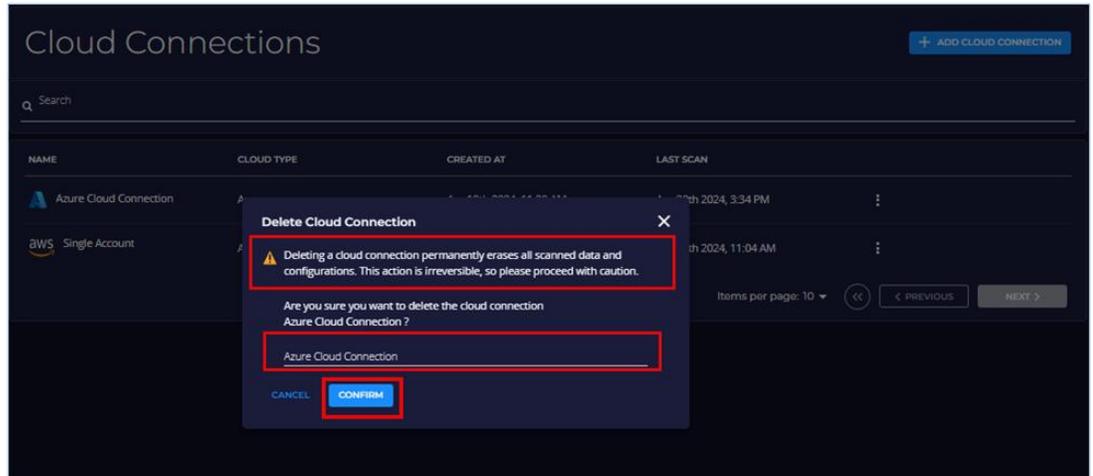
